RULE SUMMARY

The legislature directed the Department of Consumer and Business Services to regulate manufactured structure dealers through licensing. The administration of the manufactured structures dealer licensing program was transferred from the Building Codes Division to the Division of Finance and Corporate Securities (DFCS). The rules administering manufactured structures dealer licensing program are being moved to OAR chapter 441, where the rules concerning other programs administered by the DFCS are located. This rulemaking activity only includes changing administrative rule numbers and cross-references.

The agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing the negative economic impact of the rule on business.

A public rulemaking hearing may be requested in writing by 10 or more people, or by an association with 10 or more members, within 21 days following the publication of the Rulemaking Notice in the Oregon Bulletin or 28 days from the date Notice was sent to people on the agency mailing list, whichever is later. 
