13 On April 11, 1995, the Director of the Department of  
14 Consumer and Business Services for the State of Oregon  
15 issued an Order containing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of  
16 Law, and an Order to Cease and Desist and Assessing Civil  
17 Penalties. In the Order, Respondents AMERICAN WIRELESS  
18 SYSTEMS, INC. (hereinafter "AMERICAN WIRELESS"), DEXTER  
19 SELWYN COHEN (hereinafter "COHEN"), JEFFREY DANE HOWES  
20 (hereinafter "HOWES"), and STEVEN GAIL JOHNSON (hereinafter  
21 "JOHNSON"), were advised of their right to a hearing, and  
22 that a hearing would be held if a demand for such hearing  
23 was filed within 20 days after service of the Order.

24 All Respondents were duly served with copies of the  
25 Order. Service was effected by mailing a copy to each  
26 Respondent at their address by both certified and regular  
27 mail. The certified mail receipts for AMERICAN WIRELESS,  
28 HOWES, and JOHNSON, were returned with a signature affixed  
29 to each, showing that the Orders were received by each  
30 Respondent. The receipt for AMERICAN WIRELESS was signed on
