*Order of Final Judgment Incorporating Consent Order
of Permanent Injunction, Ancillary Equitable Relief, and
Civil Monetary Penalty against James John Rask*

This cause is before the Court on the joint motion by the United States Commodity Futures Trading Commission ("CFTC"), the State of Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services ("DCBS"), James John Rask ("Rask") to enter an Order of Final Judgment Incorporating the Consent Order of Permanent Injunction, Ancillary Equitable Relief, and Civil Monetary Penalty against James John Rask. All parties to this proceeding have agreed to the entry of the Final Judgment Order and agree that the entry of the Final Judgment Order will conclude this proceeding. Accordingly, the Court, having reviewed the record in this matter, directs as follows:


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Joint Motion by Plaintiffs and Defendant to Enter an Order of Final Judgment Incorporating the Consent Order of Permanent Injunction, Ancillary Equitable Relief, and Civil Monetary Penalty against James John Rask is **GRANTED**.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that final judgment is entered in this matter incorporating this Court's February 23, 2006 Consent Order of Permanent Injunction, Ancillary Equitable Relief, and Civil Monetary Penalty against James John Rask ("Consent Order"). Pursuant to the terms of the Consent Order, all proceedings in this governmental enforcement injunctive matter are concluded. The Consent Order provides for a final judgment on the merits by permanently enjoining Rask from violations of the contract market and antifraud provisions set forth in Sections 4(a) and 4b(a)(2) of the Commodity Exchange Act, as amended ("Act"), 7 U.S.C. §§ 6(a), 6b(a)(2), and the registration and antifraud provisions of the Oregon Securities Law, Oregon Revised Statutes §§ 59.055, 59.165, 59.135. In addition to a final judgment of permanent injunction, the Consent Order also directs that Rask be permanently banned from activities relating to commodity futures trading and securities trading, that Rask make full restitution, and that Rask pay a civil monetary penalty. The Consent Order provides that Rask


shall make full restitution in the amount of \$2,409,885 plus pre- and post-judgment interest. The amount of restitution represents the amount of funds that persons solicited by Rask gave to Orion as a result of the conduct alleged in the Complaint and identified as investors in Exhibit A to the Consent Order. The Consent Order further provides that Rask pay to the CFTC a civil monetary penalty in the amount of \$1,965,565 plus post-judgment interest pursuant to Section 6c of the Act, 7 U.S.C. § 13a-1, upon full satisfaction of his restitution obligation. The amount of the civil monetary penalty represents the monetary gain Rask received as a result of the course of conduct alleged in the Complaint.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this cause to assure compliance with this Order, the Consent Order, and for all other purposes related to this action.




